Dear Mr. LaPrairie:

In accordance with the surface management regulations (43 CFR 3809), we recently inspected Bristlecone Mining Company's Paiute project in Washoe County, Nevada. This operation was conducted under Notice N36-84-040N, a copy of which is enclosed for your reference.

During our inspection, we observed that the 1989 roads and dozer cuts had been constructed both in the wash, as proposed, and on the steep slopes on both sides of the wash. We could not locate any drill holes on these new roads, but noted that older drill holes on the property remain unplugged.

The disturbances on steep terrain, including older roads constructed by Denison, lack erosion control measures and have already begun to erode. Slope stability problems and further soil loss are likely to result unless interim reclamation (waterbars, outsloping the road bed) is begun.

We are therefore requesting a status report for operations conducted under Notice N36-84-040N. In the report, to be submitted to this office within 30 days of receipt of this letter, please describe the current status of the project, as well as your plans to counter further erosion on the site.

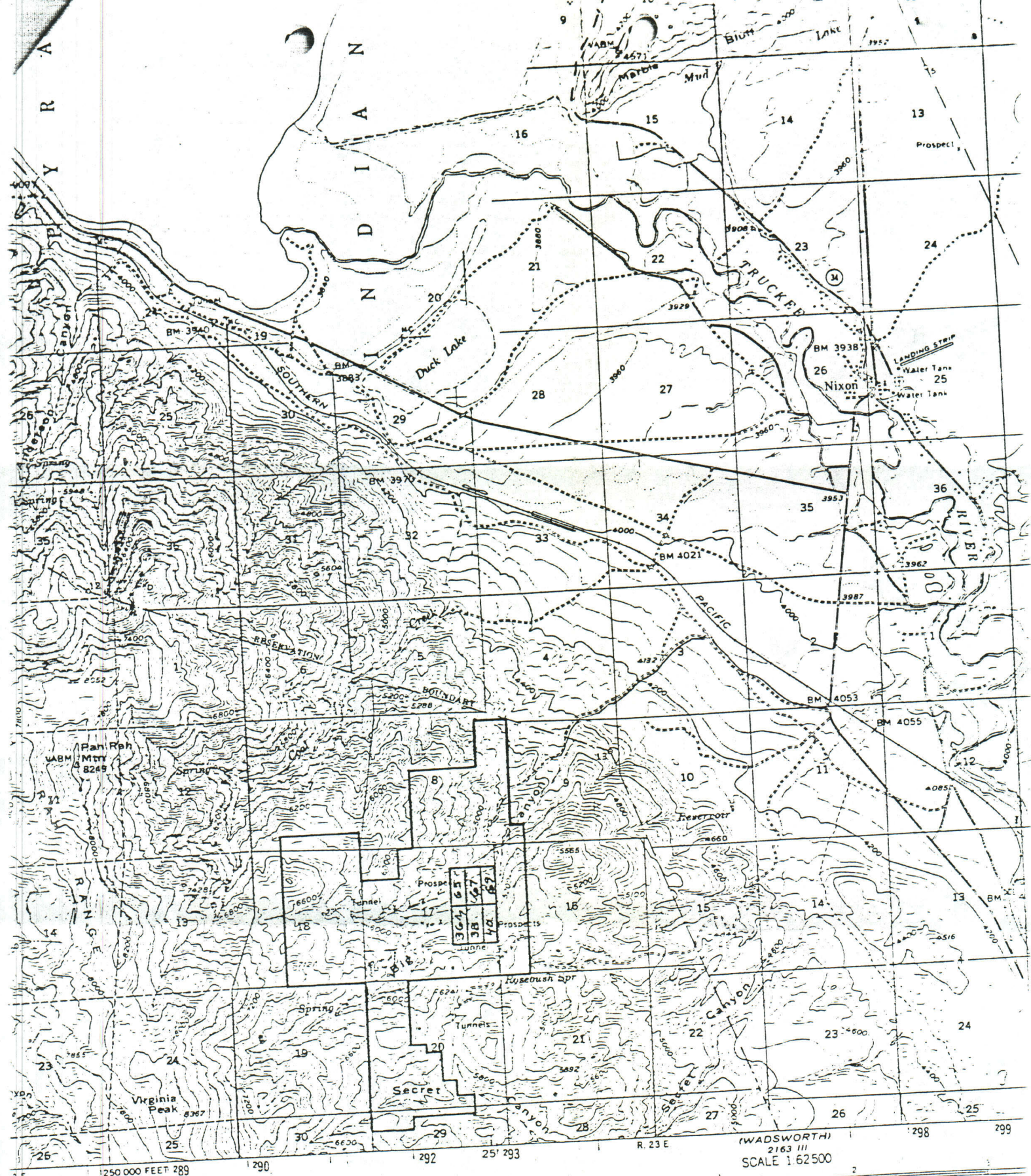

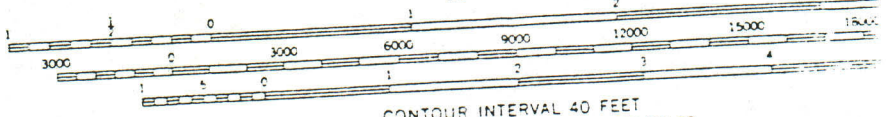
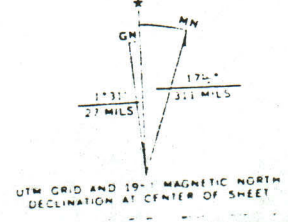
VI. Proposed Reclamation





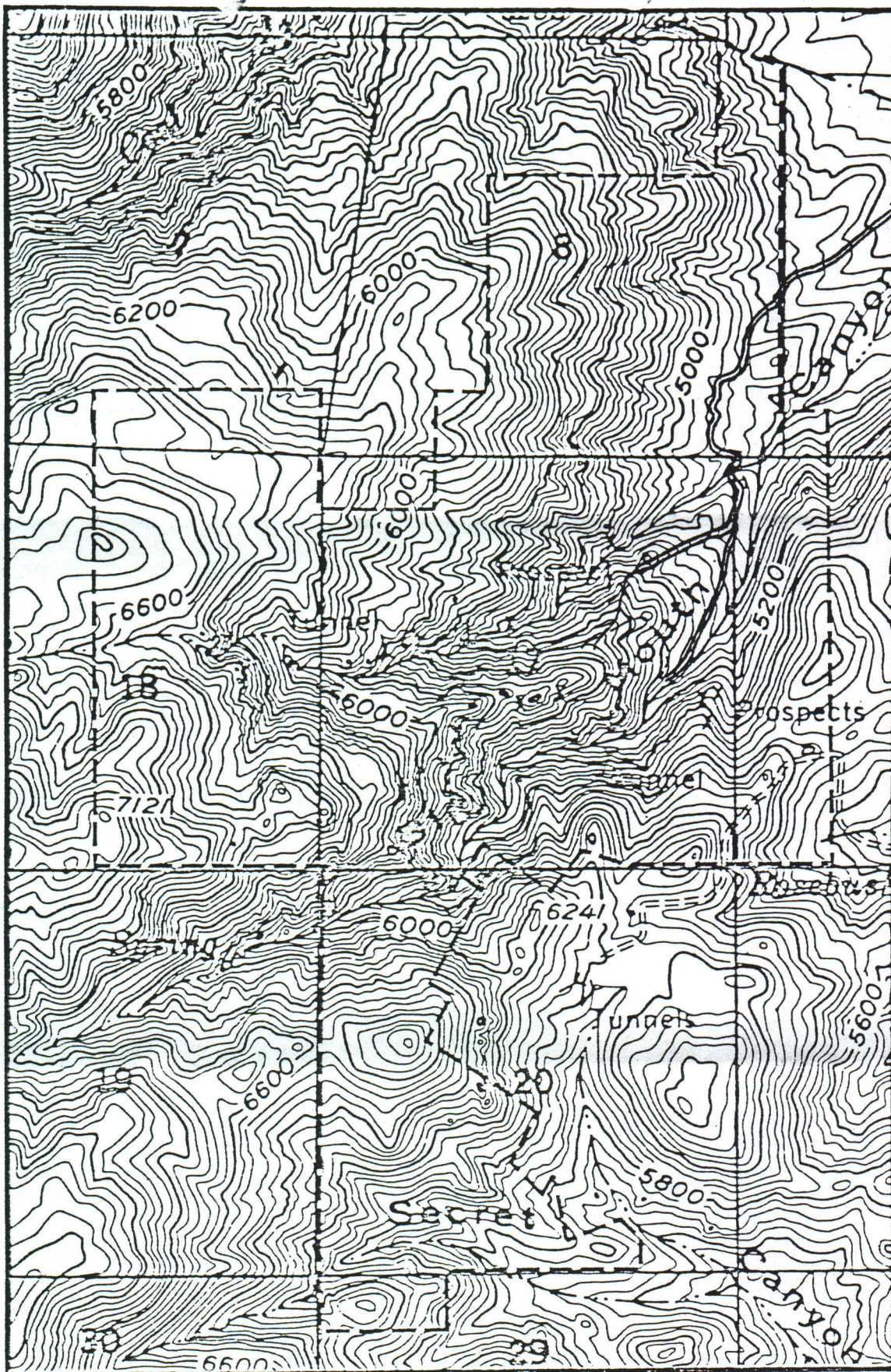

OUTLINE OF THE PAIUTE CLAIMS T22N, R23E

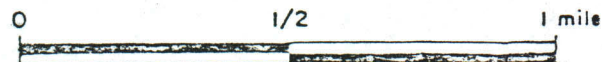
