

NAME OF PROPERTY

Dirty Shirt Tungsten (group of mining claims)

LOCATION OF PROPERTY

Located in Osceola Mining District, White Pine County, Nevada - Sections 24 and 25, Township 14 North, Range 67 East, MDBAM.

GEOLOGY

The formation is quartaite intruded by a perphyry dike about 20° to 50° thick, and 40° southeast. The vein, lying parallel along the footwall side of the dike, is a chalky white quarts carrying scheelite. This quarts shattered and cracked with numerous seams filled at times with manganese stained calcite or iron stained calcite. The latter is colored almost identical to the scheelite which also often fills similar cracks and fractures.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Consists of 2 full and 2 fractional lode mining claims - all unpatented.

Mine workings consist of 97 foot shaft at 8000 foot elevation, and an adit about 600 feet at about 7700 feet elevation driven under shaft. The shaft has levels at 55 feet and 90 feet below collar, but very little drifting has been done.

The turnel was driven on hanging wall side of dike for about 500 feet and consequently only last 90 feet were driven on footwall side of dike and in the quartz vein exposed in shaft, but no milling grade ore was exposed.
