THE FRISBEE GROUP.

The Frisbee Group was formerly owned and prospected by the Hercules Mining Company under the management of Mr. Frisbee. The Company allowed their locations to lapse and the ground was re-located.

The property is located about two miles north of the Palmetto Substation of the Nevada-California Power Company. The small vein that is developed by two tunnels of considerable length is enclosed in granite, the vein probably forming in a fault zone. The lower tunnel exposes the vein for about 300 feet and at a depth of about 150 feet below the summit of a small ridge.

The property cannot be recommended for further development by our Company.
