DEVELOPMENT: Large area of newly constructed drill roads, a few drill holes noted in southern part of claim block.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drill roads have been constructed, moving in drilling equipment (diamond drill) on day of examination.

GEOLOGY: Drill roads are in Pilot shale formation of oxidized red to buff colored silty shales & siltstones. Siltstone are bleached & Fe-stained as seen in exposed cuts of drill roads.

Andesitic basalts overlie sediments in area where sample was taken.

The sample was collected from a 10' lateral section of exposed sediments on a drill road not yet drilled but flagged as a future drill site.

REMARKS: Sample 887 - Taken from oxidized horizon exposed in one of the uppermost (in elevation) drill roads. Sample taken across 10' lateral horizon of exposed sediments. Sample is of altered siltstones of the Pilot Fm.
