HISTORY: Several, old copper prospects in the area; explored in the 1970's by UV Industries for porphyry molybdenum.

DEVELOPMENT: Old shaft, caved, surface cuts

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: East-West striking, 50S-dipping massive gossan/jasperoid zone, 3'-4' thick exposed in old shaft. Zone is in limestone, but fragments of silicified, quartz-veined porphyry dike rock found on dump, rock contains very fresh(possibly secondary) biotite.

REMARKS: Timbers at shaft collar are round, hand-hewn, with square nails. Some recent blue flagging seen, but no other signs of recent interest.
