These claims are situated east of Peavine Peak and are about one mile east of the base of the steep slope of Peavine Mountain.Equipment and Development: -Samples: ✓Geology and Mineralization: This group of claims is situated in an area composed primarily of Tertiary andesite and rhyolite but several small exposures of schist and monzonite are evident.Several dumps were examined and showed altered andesite that contained disseminated pyrite and small amounts of quartz.Remarks: In view of the fact that the past production has been from small irregular deposits, this district shows little promise for the future.
