## LOCATION OF PROPERTY

Located on east slope of Pilot Mountain, Shoshone Mining District, Mineral County, Nevada.

## GEOLOGY AND ORE OCCURRENCE

The tungsten ore in this mine occurs as a scheelite, disseminated in garnetized metamorphosed limestone beds. The garnetized bands conform to the dip of the limestone bedding, viz: dipping northwesterly into hill at about 20° and vary from 2 feet to 15 feet in thickness.

Pilot Mts dist.

On the Garnet No. 1 claim, three such bands occur: the thickest 8 feet to 15 feet and two smaller 2 feet to 3 feet thick. The outcrop of the thickest garnetized band has been open-cut or benched for 100 feet in length. In the center of the face a 7 x 7 foot incline shaft has been sunk 100 feet and a drift to the northeast was driven in the "tactite".

The last 50 foot of shaft and drift in tactite failed to expose any commercial milling ore. Apparently the commercial milling ore is confined to a block extending down the northeast wall of the shaft for about 20 feet and along northeasterly wall of the open-cut for distance of 38 feet.
