

LOCATION

On Pilot Mountain, 12 miles east of Mina, in Township 6 North, Range 36 Fast, Mineral County, Esvada,

GEOLOGY

The rock formation is described as thin bedded cherts and quartzites, intruded by monsonite dikes.

DESCRIPTION OF MINE

Some rather extensive oroppings containing cuprite, malachite and crysochola in a sporadic distribution along a shear or sheeted some attracted the attention of prospectors in the early history of the State. Later extensive development was undertaken by driving long tunnels in the expectation of finding large bedies of sulphide ore. Apparently none was found, and the tunnels are now caved. The surface ores are too low grade to be of economic importance. No reserves can be estimated.
