NAME OF PROPERTY

Dunlap Copper Mine

L. E. Cornelius, C. E. Noble, and Charles F. Noble - Mina,
Nevada - owners

LOCATION

On Pilot Mountain, 12 miles east of Mina, in Township 6 North, Range 36 East,
Mineral County, Nevada.

GEOLOGY

The rock formation is described as thin bedded cherts and quartzites, intruded
by monzonite dikes.

DESCRIPTION OF MINE

Some rather extensive croppings containing cuprite, malachite and crysochola
in a sporadic distribution along a shear or sheeted zone attracted the attention
of prospectors in the early history of the State. Later extensive development
was undertaken by driving long tunnels in the expectation of finding large
bodies of sulphide ore. Apparently none was found, and the tunnels are now
caved. The surface ores are too low grade to be of economic importance. No
reserves can be estimated.
