Adits visited strikes S50 E & is partially caved at the entrance.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, but jeep trail access on map is now a bladed 2 lane road.GEOLOGY: Adit explores unconsolidated bedded, dirty green ss which overlies a banded dark & light grey sandy dolomite. The banded appearance of the rock suggests it is the Sevy Dolomite. Altho the county map shows Devils Gate in this area.No controlling structure was observed at the working but the sediment beds dip 30-45° to NW.The dump is composed almost entirely of light grey (weathered) to dark grey(fresh) crystalline banded dolomite. Quartz & calcite veined dolomite has Mn & Fe oxs. Barite was found as clots in hot rock & as cement in fine breccia. Also some boxwork gossan on dump.Porphyritic volcanic (W) rock fragment inclined) found as float below workings. The rock has a very fine-grained pink groundmass & contains smokey quartz phenos. The county map shows scattered ash-flows & older volcanic in the canyon below workings.REMARKS: Sample 958 - Dolomite & dolomite breccia with baritePhotos
