GEOLOGY: According to Johnson 1973, The placers are found in a small area of gravel hills adjacent to Rabbithole Creek on the northeast. Most of the work is concentrated around the southern and eastern edges of the gravel hills. The gold is coarse and about 890 fine and is erratically distributed through the gravels, which range in thickness to about 25 feet or more. No evidence exist as to the source of the gold and there are no lode veins in the vicinity.
