Dear Getch:

I don't expect the returns from the samples that were sent to Goldfield until Tuesday morning. Roy hasn't returned yet, but I expect him tonight or tomorrow. You will recall that he broke off some rock and float where the new tunnel is being started. I am enclosing copy of the returns from that particular sample.

In coming down on the train, I ran into Ben Christian, who is one of the S. P. Land Agents. We had quite a visit and in discussing Betty O'Neal, Midas, etc., and how much good you were doing for the community, the subject of the Chase Camp came up and I told him I had been over there with you.

He stated the Company had sold you some ground and that you wanted to get some more, but that some one had reported a spring on a portion of the section you wished to acquire. I told him I had been there that morning and that there was no indication of water being in any spring as had been reported to them. He stated that most of the springs had dried up - practically all of them and that there was no reason why the company should not sell you the balance of this section.

No doubt this conversation will reach headquarters, or has so already, and that he will recommend the sale. So, I think it is advisable for you to follow up this matter on your next trip to San Francisco.

I shall not go to San Francisco before Tuesday night and might stay until you arrive so as to be there about the same time you are and I could see you here on your arrival.

I will send along the results of Roy's sampling as soon as they arrive.
