The other day at Getchell Mine I discussed with Fred Barnes the acquisition by CONOCO of the 4 Dry Ridge claims on this prospect. He asked me what I thought was fair so I mentioned a 1% ORR on ore produced from these claims. I understand you had already determined that we would have no apex or extra lateral problem with him during your recent discussion with him in the Albuquerque office. Fred replied he thought 3% would be a more reasonable figure. He will discuss with John Etchardt his partner.

The situation we have here is unusual. I explained to Fred that our general policy is not to look at ground that the person submitting does not control. In this case Barney Berger and Fred located the claims in his name as well as the 16 Burn Out claims for CONOCO. The Dry Ridge claims are located on a vein system which has produced silver in the past and was the basis of Fred's interest in the ground. These claims may be peripheral to our area of greatest interest but must be considered a part of the prospect as we now see it.



Ok, so now I have copies of the recorded Location Certificates for the "BURN OUT" 5 thru 20 claims, and they go with the map that I brought back with me before this stuff was recorded. I guess I didn't say it right on the phone the other day, though, because this still doesn't answer the question. What I was talking about had to do with the specific group of claims in which Fred is to get his royalty.

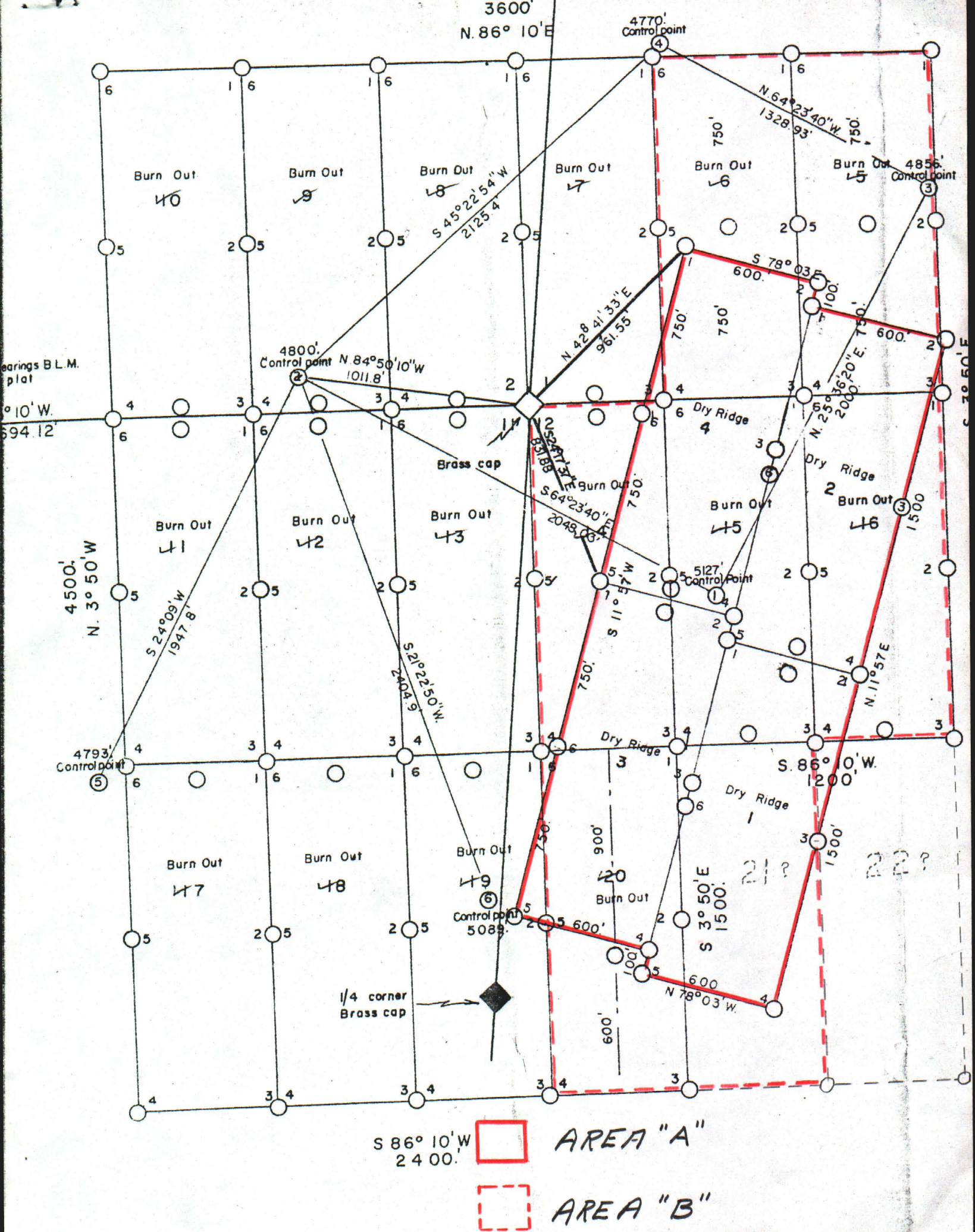
If it's Area "A", as on attached plat out of the location map, then I need the Location Certificates for the "DRY RIDGE" claims. In this case we have to have an Assignment from Fred et al in which they reserve a 2% NSR royalty. Going this route will require giving these four claims a separate lease number and maintaining the group as such from then on.

If we go the other route, that is, Area "B", all we do is give Fred et al an Agreement And Grant Of Royalty in our own claims as they cover same, and forget about the "DRY RIDGE" claims. This, of course, means adding the "BURN OUT" No. 21, but I was under the impression that Barney was going to do the 21 and 22, and more, anyway. Obviously, I prefer this route because it is a lot cleaner from a lease maintenance point of view. From my conversation with Fred I thought I understood him to be agreeable to same. I didn't get the impression that he had any fixation about the four "DRY RIDGE" claims.

However, the way you all went ahead with this, i.e., recording the map with the "DRY RIDGE" claims shown on it indicates to me that they are being, or have been, recorded too. I hope not, but if so, it makes a lot of difference as to how we go about this and that's what I'm trying to find out. All this, of course, assumes that the map that the Location Certificates for the "BURN OUT" claims show as Document No. 165773 is the same Caldwell map that was given me.

Such Assignment And Agreement will further provide:


- 1- For the reservation unto the assignors of a production royalty of 2% of net mint or smelter returns on all production from the lands covered by the subject claims.



Your letter of September 16, 1975 to Messrs. Barnes and Etchart in explanation of the assessment of the consideration paid for the subject assignment and conveyance as a "net proceeds of mines" has been forwarded to me for response. I believe the evidence you have requested, that is, that the \$400 paid Messrs. Barnes and Etchart is neither a rental nor royalty, is in the attached copies of the draft in payment of the \$400 Cashier's Check and the first page of the Assignment and Conveyance itself.

The reporting of the payment by Continental as a royalty was in error, though understandable. As we understand the reporting requirements, which are not actually set forth in the law but, rather, in Regulation No. 26, a lessee, prior to the enactment of A.B. 198, was required to report all payments to the owner of a mining claim. Whether or not such payment is subject to the net proceeds of mine tax depends upon the nature of the payment as set forth in the instrument creating same. The fact, in this instance, is that the payment was consideration for the Assignment and Conveyance and not a rental or advance royalty.

We hope this letter and its enclosures are sufficient to satisfy the Nevada Tax Commission on this point.



The Getchell property was acquired on April 1, 1972, by a Lease/Option (MC-44) from the Goldfield Corporation of Melbourne, Florida. On March 31, 1975, Conoco farmed out the tungsten to General Electric, MC-162, because G. E. agreed to pay 1/3 of the \$80,000 annual payment to Goldfield. On February 28, 1977, Conoco transferred its remaining interest and obligations in the Getchell property to G. E. reserving only a conditional 2% NSR on the gold, and a section and one-half of land that is a part of the Striped Hills prospect. Conoco pays \$3,657.00 for this land to G. E. by March 31, of each year. If we wish to surrender this land and avoid the payment, notice must be given to G. E. by December 31.

Since February of 1977, G. E. has purchased Utah, International. Utah has taken over G. E.'s exploration of Getchell and all of my acquaintances within G. E. have quit. I sent a letter to Utah suggesting that Conoco will drop the land provided they will give us a 2% royalty on the land if we drop it, but I haven't received a response.

Pursuant to the joint memo of December 13, from G. L. Pine and C. P. Hahn to W. A. Petersen and G. H. Mayberry, the Reno office is suggesting that this patented land be dropped by December 31, so Conoco won't be tied to the \$3,657.00 payment. A response will be needed by Friday December 29.

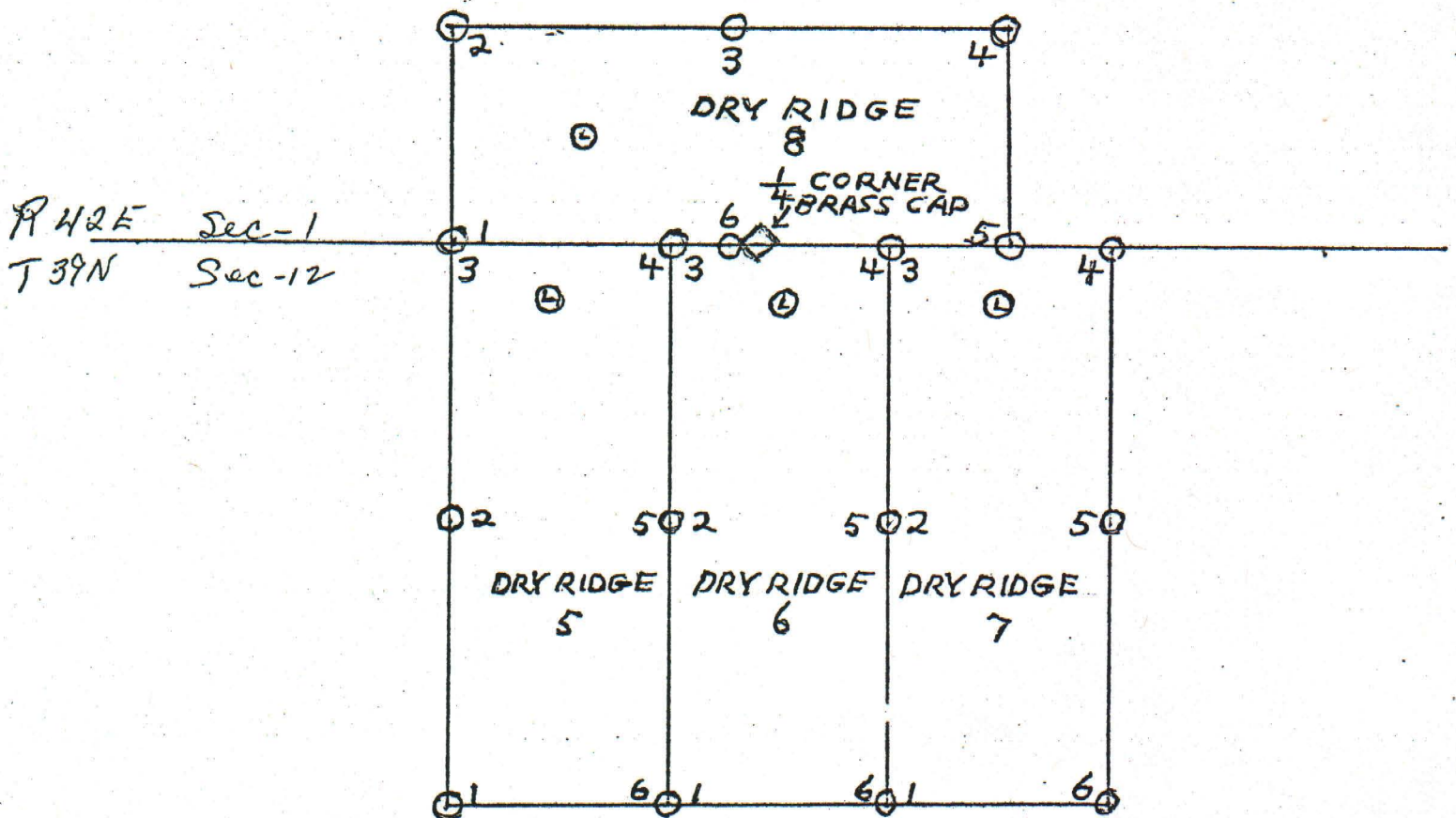

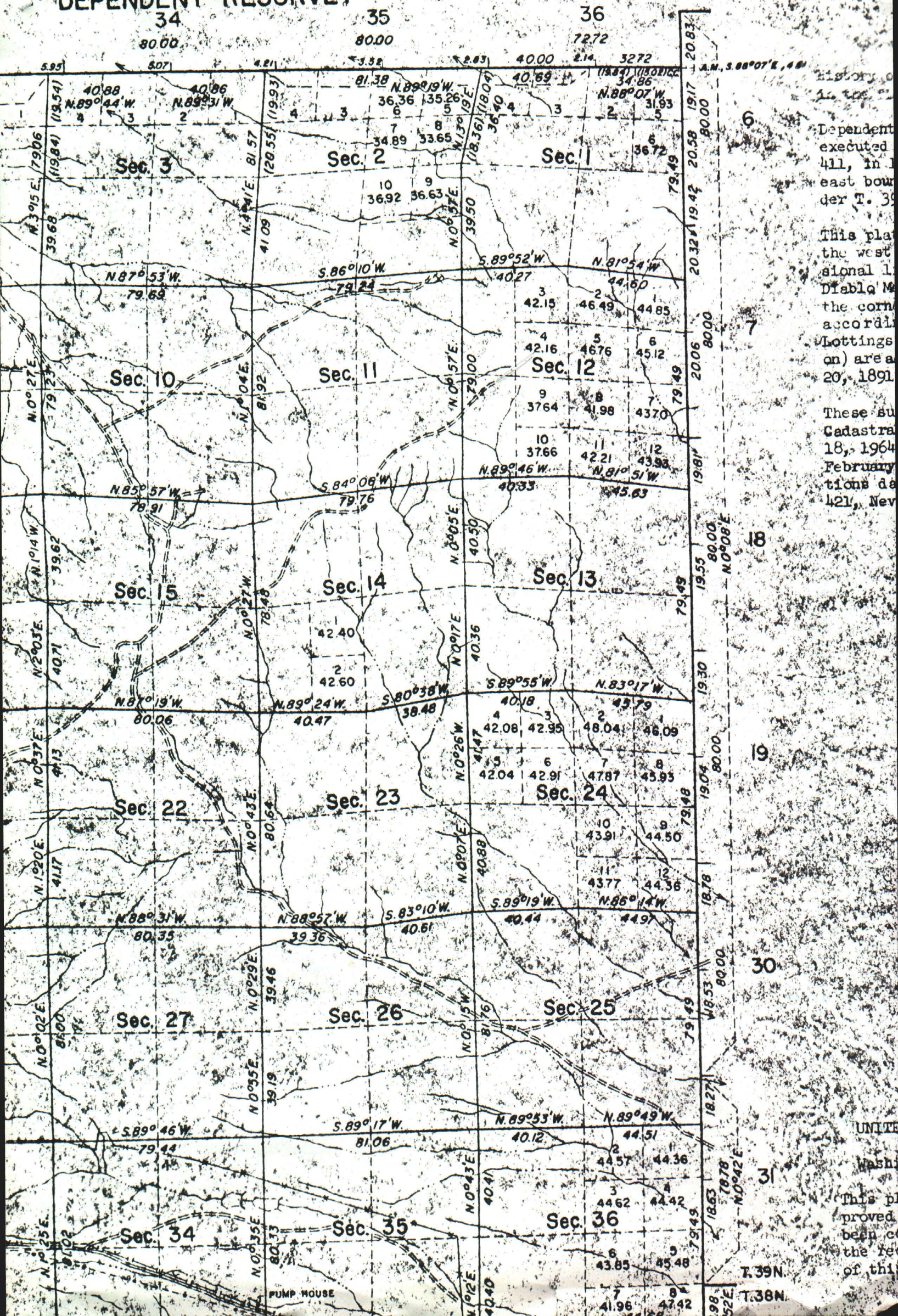
