GEOLOGY: Most of the area is underlain with carbonate rocks of the Guilmette Formation of Devonian age or silicified rocks formed from them. Several large bodies of silicified and brecciated jasperoid are associated with intrusive breccia pipes. The remainder of the area is covered by Tertiary volcanics. Relatively low-grade fluorospar mineralization occurs along the margins of the silicified zones. Sample 1781 was of silicified breccias and jasperoid and contained .10ppm Au with minor As, Sb, and Zn.
