GEOLOGY: The vein is a greenish-gray, purple and white pod-shaped intrusive in a reddish-brown volcanic breccia. Some of the vein material has been stock piled but the size of the workings suggest there has been very little production. A small campsite about 1/4 mile south of the workings is still intact but has not been occupied for some time. There are no signs of recent activity. Sample 1998 was chipped from the vein exposure in the shaft. Analysis did not detect Au.
