GEOLOGY: Prospect pits are along narrow N80°E veins in light-gray porphyritic rhyolite. The vein is Fe-Mn stained vuggy slightly greenish fluorspar/quartz that looks to be very low-grade, and there doesn't seem to be a whole lot of it. The sample 1772 did not have detectable Au.
