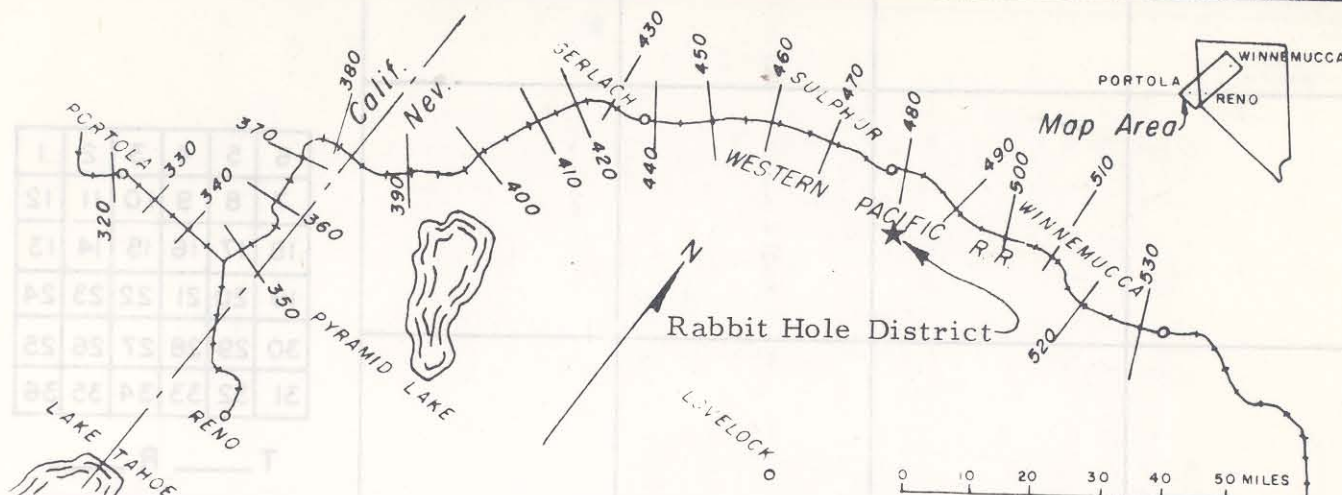

**DESCRIPTION:** Placers in recent gravels 2-12 feet, averaging 4 feet deep. Sporadic operations since 1916 with a location made as early as 1900. Several attempts to work on large scale have failed. Largest nugget reported near Barrel Springs; value \$17.50. Water has been a problem - much has been by dry washing of the gravels. Some current placer activity of dubious importance by Lakeshore Minerals (over)

**RESERVES:** Dubious, claim up to 1 billion cubic yards of gravel locally worth \$1/ton in gold, tin, mercury, and magnetite.

**ACCESS:** Six miles north by improved road to Western Pacific Railroad at Sulphur.

**OWNERSHIP:** 271 placer claims covering about 50,000 acres held jointly by three companies: Industrial and Petroleum, Inc., 530 California Ave., Reno, Nevada; Constant De Rebecque Inc. (same address); and Lakeshore Minerals Refining Company

**SOURCES OF DATA:** U. S. Bureau of Mines Information Circular 6902, p. 25-26, (over) 1936 and field visit plus county records.

**ECONOMICS:** Need \$125,000.00 additional capital (in return for 12.5 percent royalty) to construct larger mill.

**CONCLUSIONS:** Questionable.
