GEOLOGY: Outcrops around shaft are mostly granodiorite, some small, irregular pods of skarn. A small hill to the north of the shaft is composed of massive white quartz. Several cuts and trenches to the south and west of the shaft expose fingers of skarn along an irregular granodiorite-sediment contact, granodiorite is to the north, sediments to the south. Rock on the Copper Queen dump is mostly pale red-brown garnet skarn containing minor amounts of pyrite.
