GEOLOGY: Four-foot wide shear zone, N10°E, 70°NW, which cuts garnet skarn. East (footwall) side of zone is white, crystalline marble, the west (hanging-wall) side of the zone is tactite. Pods of massive white quartz occur along the shear zone, quartz contains clots of red-brown and cinn. brown goossan, some quartz on the dump contains disseminated pyrite. Melanite and green copper minerals present. There are pieces of granodiorite on the dump, may be a contact cut by underground workings.
