SHEBY MINE

The Sheby, or New Toy, mine is about 2 miles west of Toy on the east side of the Trinity Range, at an altitude of about 5,000 feet. Operated by the Trojan Mining Co. in 1953-54, the North Wind Mining Co. in 1955-56, and by B. M. Clark in 1956-57, the property yielded small tonnages of ore that averaged about 0.5 percent WO₃.

Scheelite-bearing tactite occurs along the east edge of the St. Anthony granodiorite stock where it is in contact with calcareous metasedimentary rocks. The ore mined and shipped contained from 0.4 to 1.1 percent WO₃.
