DEVELOPMENT: Tunnel is south-west trending & partially caved. New roads leading up canyon to main district have cut through large dumps located below tunnel. Core shack sit on dumps. Artesian spring flows out of portal.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: See Below

GEOLOGY: The Davis Tunnel was quickly visited on the way to the main district. The dumps below the Tunnel are quite voluminous & are mostly composed of bleached white marble & recrystallized grey limestone. Bagged drill cuttings & sections of 1" diameter core lie on top of the dumps. The core on the dump is mainly composed of marble & intrusive rock with some pyrite occurring along veins.

A few storage sheds on property contain equipment, bagged cuttings & core.

No sample was taken since the source of core & dump material is not known.

The Davis Tunnel was primarily used as lower access to Bunker Hill Mines.
