DEVELOPMENT: Four shafts, five adits and numerous prospects, poor roads.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, although there has been some geochemical surveying but it is hard to tell how old it is, maybe five years?

GEOLOGY: The mine workings are in cherts and quartzite of the Palmetto Formation. All of the workings are old, caved and without any buildings. Photo #16. The mineralization is associated with quartz veins that have intruded the older sediments that strike N15W and dip at 40-60 degrees to the SW. The veins are very tight and the quartz is very hard to break even with a geologic pick. There is some brecciation and rather limited mineralization on the dumps. The single exception is the eastern most dump. Sample #1118.
