DEVELOPMENT: Single open pit 50 ft. long, or large exploration trench. Many new & wide roads in area.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Recently geochemed.

GEOLOGY: Surrounding area is honey-combed with new roads (less than 10 years old). On the drive up massive where veins outcrop. At sample site highly fractured, FeOx stained, fine to coarse grained, medium grey quartzite with disseminated fresh and oxidized pyrite and pyrite ghosts. On the dumps, but not found in outcrops were Limestone breccia cemented with turquoise, tactite, shale/slate, and phyllites. Set of shears dip steeply NE. No work done for at least 10 years. Minor hemimorphite and dendritic pyrolusite coats surface.

Lamped showed specks of scheelite.
