ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Site is small to medium size open pit with at least 7 benches on the North side and 3 benches on South, lots of drill roads & holes. No activity in at least 10 years. Standing water. Outhouse, cables and pipes. Area in huge shear zone with beds (thin) of quartzite, shles mudstone in all orientation. Shear appears to be trending E-W and dipping E. Various degrees of metamorphisn from shale to muscovite shist, some epidotization, minor calcite. Milky white quartz veining from inches up to 2 feet, light & dark banded crystalline pyrite in bands and randomly disseminated throughout quartzite.

Lamped shows specks of scheelite.
