Location 3 claims in unsurveyed land, roughly T. 13 N, R. 32 E., 55.5 miles by road
southeast of Fallon, Nevada

History and production Claims located in 1941 by the Grutt Bros. being developed by the Goldfield Consolidated Mining Co. under a lease and purchase agreement. Approximately 110 tons ore removed from the adit drift and is reported to contain 2% WO₃.

Type Deposit (Geology) Rocks of the area are mainly granodiorite, limestone and dark fine grained intrusive rocks common to the district, probably diorites, dolerites or andesite porphyries. Garnetization has occurred along some of the limestone-granodiorite contact. Numerous small "islands" or roof pendants were found. Only schulite occurrence of importance is on such a contact - see map.

Mine Workings Consist of a short adit, 100 feet in length, a 12 foot raise in the adit and a winze 10 feet deep in the adit.
