GENERAL BACKGROUND

Area NW-38-1 lies south - southwest of Rawhide and west of Gabbs Valley. Only a relatively few prospects are in the area, and its designation as an "Indicated Mineral Area" is based primarily on favorable geologic conditions.

Mineral commodities that could be discovered in the area include gold, silver, tungsten and iron.

GEOLOGIC AND TECHNICAL DATA

The area is overlain by rhyodacite to andesite flows, tuffs, and breccia. The Esmeralda and Pre-Esmeralda volcanic and sedimentary rocks are projected to underlie the area.

POTENTIAL FOR DEVELOPMENT

Geologic inference suggests that the host rocks for mineralization at Rawhide are concealed by younger rocks in area NW-38-1.

If this is true similar mineral deposits may yet be discovered.


