## LOCATION

Red Canyon Mining District, Douglas County, Nevada, about 14 miles from Hudson, a station on the Copper Belt Railroad.

## GEOLOGY

Areal geology consists of a granite uplift later intruded by siliceous dikes. Principal exposure on the property in which mineralization is evident is an irregular vein ranging from a mere seam to 6 inches in width. Mineralization is in the form of small discontinuous lenses, containing lead, antimony, and arsenic minerals in a quartz gangue. They are said to show high values in silver and lead.

## DEVELOPMENT

About 200 feet of adit tunnel and crosscuts carried out on minor structures. Crosscuts driven without reference to mineralization.
