

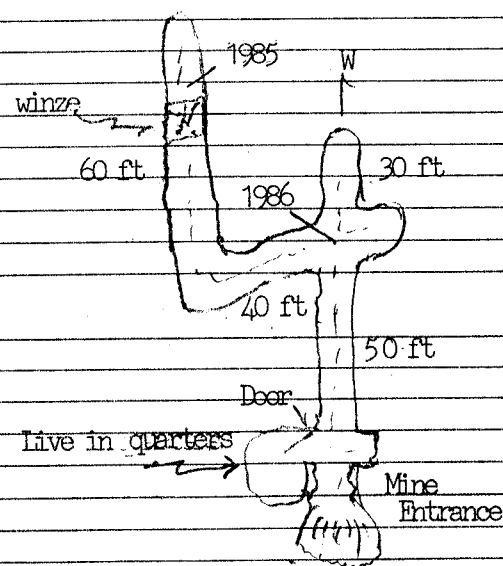

DEVELOPMENT: Adit including live-in quarters.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None. Assessment work was posted and new staking was in evidence.

GEOLOGY: The small unmarked mine is in a steep drainage south of Argentite Canyon. The 80 foot main adit is a cross-cut that intercepts a NE trending vein that outcrops at the surface. A parallel adit off a second drift has a 30 foot winze which follows the vein (see sketch below). Sample 1985 was taken of the vein next to the winze while Sample 1986 was taken where the vein was crosscut in the main adit. Analysis of the quartz vein material showed anomalous Mo, Hg, Ba, and minor Ag. Sample 1985 had 3.2ppm Au.
