GEOLOGY: The prospect is from a N30E, 75NW hydrothermally altered quartz, calcite vein with both mineralization and brecciation within the matrix. The vein is in a purplish-brown porphyritic latite that itself has been altered along the strike of the vein and for several feet on both sides.

The sample 1969 contained highly anomalous amounts of Ba, Mn and Sr with lesser amounts of Ag (300ppm) Pb and Cu.
