ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, however, dumps up canyon being processed for Ag.

GEOLOGY: Site is one of 3 adits on north side of New York Canyon. Adit trends N10W (might not be accurate because so much iron laying around) into fractured & veined granodiorite (part of Austin pluton?) veins dip 30-45' NW. Site has 2 buildings, railosytem and from size of dump, at least 1000' of workings. From the dumps not much mineralization. However, sample 628A is a high graded quartz vein, material from behind the house, containing sulfide?? 628 B, taken from the dump is a grey mud/siltstone containing surface hemimorphite and specular hematite.
