ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None for at least 20 years.

GEOLOGY: Site is single partially caved, trending due east approximately 100 feet deep. Rocks at adit portal blue-grey, thinly bedded, siliceous, N40W, 50NE. Phyllite is highly faulted adit sheared with set of fractures N65E and dipping 35-80° NW. Dump material is medium-grey Limestone, fine-grained & cut with white crystalline calcite, Limestone breccia cemented with calcite. Crystalline fresh & oxidized pyrite fine to 1/2 cm. Though no galena found, density of calcite indicates finely disseminated galena.

REMARKS: Possible in fault in Cambrian Crane Canyon Sequence.
