DEVELOPMENT: Several shafts, prospects and trnching along exposed veins.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The major workings are on a vein bearing N15°E, 40NW in andesite and consist of several inclines and numerous prospects. A second vein bears N40°W and dips vertically is in a shear and about 3 feet wide. The qtz occurs as stringers within a white-reddish-orange gouge. The vein can be traced for about 300 feet along the strike. The area has been drilled but it looks to be over 5 years ago? The workings are near in andesite but adjacent to exposures of Lunning limestone and a Cretaceous granite. Sample 3147 came from the dump and the exposed vein and consisted of quartz with some pyrite and possible base metal sulfides.
