DEVELOPMENT: Approximately eight inclines, open-stopps, trenches and prospects.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The inclines are on a N40°W shear dipping variously to the southeast.  
The host rocks are a highly altered and bleached volcanic that is near  
the contact with the Lunning Limestone Formation. The quartz is dull  
gray with wispy streaks of silver sulfide? and some pyrite (Sample 3148),  
and was collected from the eastern end of the vein system. Sample 3149  
was from the western end of the vein system next to the largest mine  
workings which is a two compartment vertical shaft..with very large  
adjacent dumps. The sample contains minor quartz vein material with gray  
unidentified sulfides that are probably silver sulfides?  
None of the workings are shown on the map for the area although some  
prospects have been noted?? There are also no reports on these workings  
in the data base???
