DEVELOPMENT: Several shallow shafts, adits and prospects have been oblitarated by
open-pit operations in the early 1980's.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The original shallow shafts followed vein in limestones..that have now been open-pitted. Sample 2734 was selected from a large dump on the eastside of the pit area. The sample contained visable copper oxides and yellow antim-onial oxides. Assays contained 700ppm Ag, 1500ppm Sb, 7000ppm Cu and 200ppm As. The eastern edge of the pit is bounded by a huge quartz outcrop wihin the lime-stone that exceeds 30 feet in width and extends N-S for several hundred feet. Sample 2735 was selected from exposed veins within the western -pit that includ-ed quartz breccia with secondary quartz and gray streaks of sulfides. Assay values were 700ppm Ag, 1500ppm Cu with lessor amounts of antimony and lead.
