group of 14 claims located ten miles south of Wellington.

Rocks in the area include meta-andesites interbedded with mica schists. Metamorphosed limestone crops out in a few places. The meta-andesites are cut by dikes of aplite and quartz monzonite. North-south faults cut both the limestone and meta-andesites. Tungsten minerals occur as scheelite along north-south faults in the meta-andesite and is localized by cross-fractures. The scheelite, finely disseminated is associated with copper carbonates, chalcoppyrite and pyrite. No production of tungsten is reported.
