DEVELOPMENT: 1 shaft \approx 30' deep with wood frame around collar. Several prospects in vicinity as marked on map.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Shaft begins in alluvium, but rock on dump is mostly a grey-brown, fine-grained silty limestone with scattered fossil fragments. Some of the rock is cut by silicified veinlets & coarser calcite veins. Some breccia on dump with pebble size limestone fragments cemented with calcite. Small amount Fe & limonite. Minor amount of bleaching & silic of limestone noted.

Prospect up the road are dogholes outgrown with bushes in limestone alluvium.
