DEVELOPMENT: 1 N25W adit \approx 50' deep or more (Shown as shaft on topo map) on W side of road. Across road to E is a caved N60W adit in limestone.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: On west side of road we took sample 726 of altered rock from mouth of adit. Portal is initially dug in alter volcanic (pumice) & limestone alluvium & then explores limestone at depth. Limestone on dump appeared unmineralized so sample was taken of altered volcanic & sediments contact. All rocks are unconsolidated.

Adit on E side of road is in thinnly bedded silty beige limestone. The beds strike N25W, 50SW. No mineralization evident.

Robinson porphyry is quite close to these workings.
