GEOLOGY: Quartz vein approx. 1/3 meter thick, striking N60W, dipping 50°NE in Weaver rhyolite. Rhyolite adjacent to vein is sericitized and somewhat schistose. Some tourmalinization of wall rock also. Vein contains pyrite, galena, sphalerite, tetrahedrite? and chalcopryite (minor). Galena is most abundant base metal sulfide.
