GEOLOGY: Vein fault in main adit bears almost E W as was sunk in rhyolite. Extreme alteration along structure and into the country rock. Sample 1800 was taken from vein within the large lower adit about 50 feet from the entrance. The vein varies in width and strike but is close to vertical. It is very punky except for areas of silication with other areas being vuggy and brecciated.
