EUREKA PROPERTY

ROUND MOUNTAIN MINING DISTRICT
NYE COUNTY, NEVADA.

LOCATION

This property is located in the Round Mountain Mining District about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles east of the town of Round Mountain. Tonopah 70 miles south is the nearest railroad point.

CLAIMS AND TITLE

The group consists of four full claims known as the Eureka, North Star No. 1, North Star No. 2 and the North Star No. 3. All the claims are owned by Mr. McGibbons and Mr. Geo. Foley, of Round Mountain, whose title is possessory being by right of discovery and location.

FACILITIES

Transportation. All supplies must be hauled from Tonopah over a very good road a distance of seventy miles.

Water. Ample water for domestic purposes and for a small mill can be obtained from Shoshone Creek which passes thru the property.

Power. Electric power can be obtained at Round Mountain, a power line $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles long will transmit power to the property.

Timber. Small timber grows on the property enough for camp purposes and a small amount could be used for mining.

GEOLOGY & ORE DEPOSITS

The rock formation in this district is all rhyolite flows of varying texture. On this property the ore streak lies on the contact between a very granular rhyolite and a very fine grained rhyolite. The ore is a fine grained quartz with talc and purple fluorite associated. With this fluorite there are spots where gold can be seen in quite noticeable patches. The vein is quite small, varying in width from 2 inches to 2½ feet.

PRICES AND TERMS

The purchase price for this property is \$15,000.00. Terms, no cash down but payments scattered over a period of two years.

DEVELOPMENT

Development consists of two tunnels on the Eureka claim one 20 feet long and one 100 feet long.

PRODUCTION

There has been no production.

EQUIPMENT

There is no equipment on the property.

CONCLUSIONS

The vein is so small and the possibility for enlargement is improbable; this, combined with the spotted character of the vein makes the property unworthy of further consideration.

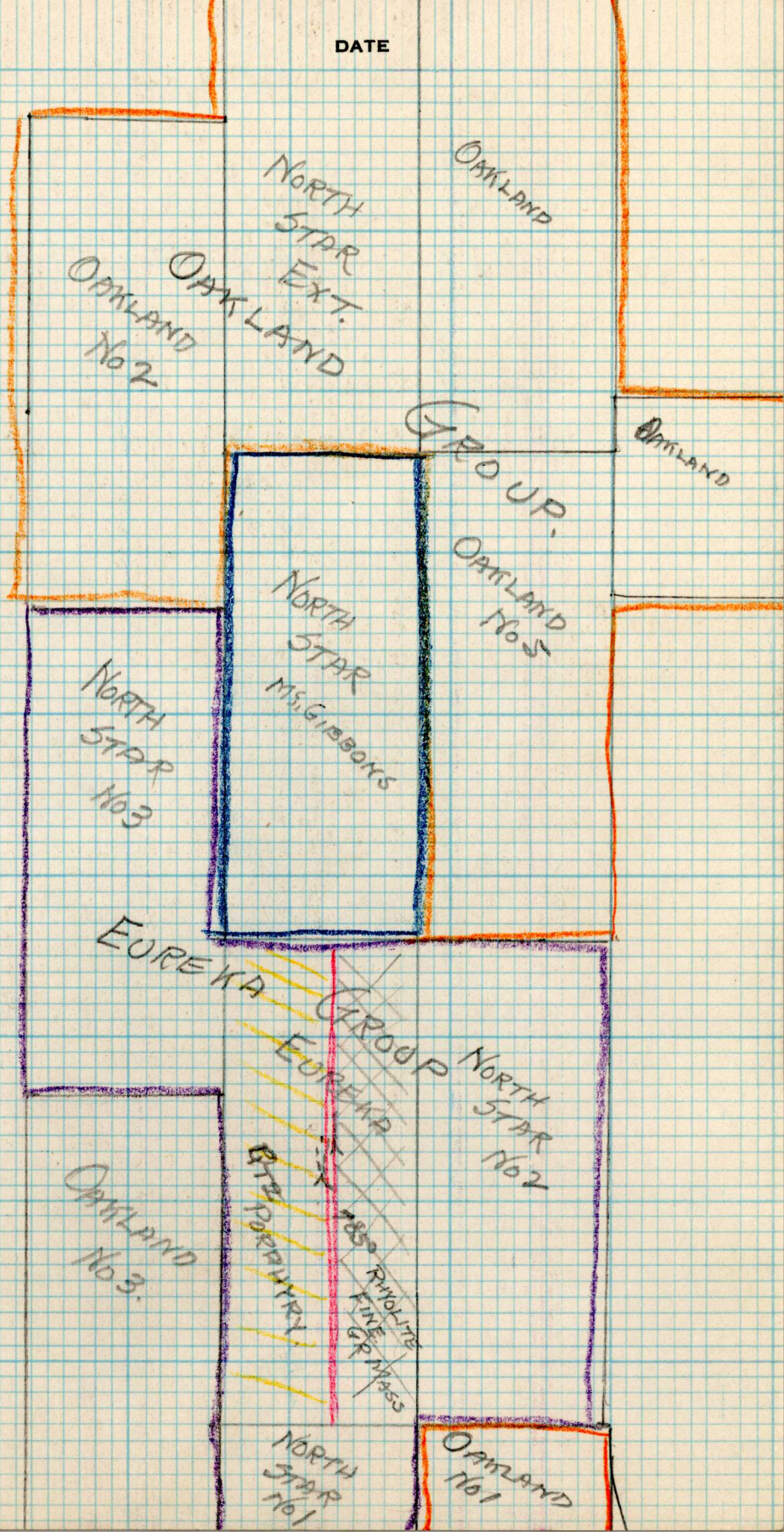
