Mines $2\frac{1}{2}$ m. e. of Round Mountain, 65 m. from Tonopah. Property includes 2 m. along tungsten belt. Alt. 7000'. Stunted pine and juniper; Shoshone Creek carried 100 miners inches of water when examined; less later in season. Formation granite, carrying quartz veins containing hübnerite. Belt 300' wide; veins numerous $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 3' wide. Tunnel #1 shows milling ore 3' - 10' wide; Tunnel #2, 4 - 12'; Tunnel #3, 3' - 14'. Ore blocked out 200,000 tons, 4% concentrate. Good millsite. Mining, milling and concentration should not exceed \$2.50 a ton.
