T H E V R U S T Y P I C K P R O S P E C T

The Rusty Pick prospect is located in Rocky Canyon, Humboldt Range, Humboldt County, Nevada. Rye Patch - six miles distant - is the nearest railroad point.

This property was examined on Sept 12, 1913, and a report made Sept. 24th. For a general discussion of the property see that report.

The accompanying map and sections show the extent of the development work since September.

The small, high-grade vein sampled at that time has been mined until but little of the good ore remained. A quartz vein - from three to seven feet in width - has been developed on the footwall of the small vein, and the average assay is about six dollars per ton. Practically no work has been done to determine the extent of this vein along the strike. The ore is hard, coarse-grained quartz, carrying considerable light-colored pyrite. Sulphide concentrates from the upper levels assay \$44.70 per ton.

The location of the samples taken and the results obtained are given on the longitudinal section.

The terms under which this second examination was made were as follows: Total Price - \$25,000. \$5000 cash within thirty days, and the balance at the company's convenience.

Conclusions

The property is not worth taking over under the above terms, and at the present stage of the development work. The holder of the present option - Ed Orr - expects to make the above \$5000 payment and get full ownership of the property. He will then develop by crosscuts
