ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, long idle, area staked J.K. claims 3-5 years ago.

GEOLOGY: Quartz veins and veinlets to 30 cm, parallel to bedding in Prida limestone. Trend N80W, dip 20 NE. Veins contain minor sericite, trace dark gray sulfide, some calcite and presumably scheelite. Limestone near veins is partially bleached, pyritized and recrystallized along bedding. Now iron-stained due to pyrite oxidation.
