Dear Interested Public:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Winnemucca Field Office (WFO) is seeking public input regarding a Plan of Operations received from Nevada Cement Company to mine limestone near Rye Patch Reservoir. Nevada Cement's mine would be located at the west base of the Humboldt Range about 25 miles northeast of Lovelock in Pershing County. The mining operation is proposed within T. 30 N., R. 33 E., and involves 145.2 acres of public land and 41.5 acres of private land. A map submitted by Nevada Cement Company in its Plan of Operations is enclosed for your reference.

The proposed mining operation would remove approximately 1 to 1½ million tons of cement grade limestone each year for 50 years from an open pit east of the Humboldt River Ranch Association and transport it to the west side of I-80.

The proposed operation infrastructure includes:

- Limestone quarry and crushing facility T. 30 N., R. 33 E., section 14
- Electricity distribution from existing substation in T. 30 N., R. 33 E., section 9
- Water well T. 30 N., R. 33 E., section 10
- Covered conveyor transport T. 30 N., R. 33 E., sections 4, 8, 9, 10, 14, 15
- Truck haul route T. 30 N., R. 33 E., sections 10, 14, 15, 16
- Shipping facility T. 30 N., R. 33 E., section 8
- Rail transport area T. 30 N., R. 33 E., section 8
- Haul road from Standard Mine to Project Echo T. 30 N., R. 33 E., sections 1, 2, 10, 11

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the BLM Winnemucca Field Office will be preparing a NEPA document for the proposed project. The NEPA document will disclose the environmental impacts expected to occur should the project be implemented. The BLM is seeking your input regarding issues, concerns or applicable knowledge that will assist in the preparation of this document.

The BLM encourages public participation in the process. To facilitate this, public open house scoping meetings will be held on Tuesday, January 16, at the Airport Plaza Hotel, 1981 Terminal Way, in Reno and on Wednesday, January 17, at Sturgeons Ramada Inn, 1420 Cornell Avenue in Lovelock. Both meetings will begin at 4:00 p.m. and end at 7:00 p.m. For further information on the project, contact Ken Loda at (775) 623-1500.
