In the Sacramento Dist, discovery of a new ledge, the MONTANA; location about sixteen miles southwest of Unionville; in the neighborhood of the BULLION ledge.

Mountain of quartz ceopping our 30 feet above surface and 25 feet thick, and runs 500 feet on trend; considered a mass or silver ore that will run \$50 per ton., Mill to be built on the Humboldt river, about 6 miles distant, with an easy down grade the entire distance.

A lot of 100 pounds of ore from near Holts mill ran \$1400/T

Montana ledge has been sold to a New York Company, the Aetna, and plans were for the errection of a stamp mill.

The Montana claim is being energetically worked. The ore from the start was of such quality that the proprietors determined on the erection of a mill, which is now completed and running, and known as the STEVENSON mill. It is furnished with ten of Vameys pans. The mill has just been started and although no clean-up has been at the latest dates, the results were entirely satisfactory.
