GEOLOGY: A series of prospects along a north-trending vein system in siltstone, that bear N45°E and dip irregularly. Sample 2838 was a brecciated and silicified portion of a vein with pyrite, antimony and possible Ag. Sample 2839 was to the north of the first site by about 300 yards and contained visible pyrite and other sulfides in a quartz vein and into the adjoining siltstone host.
