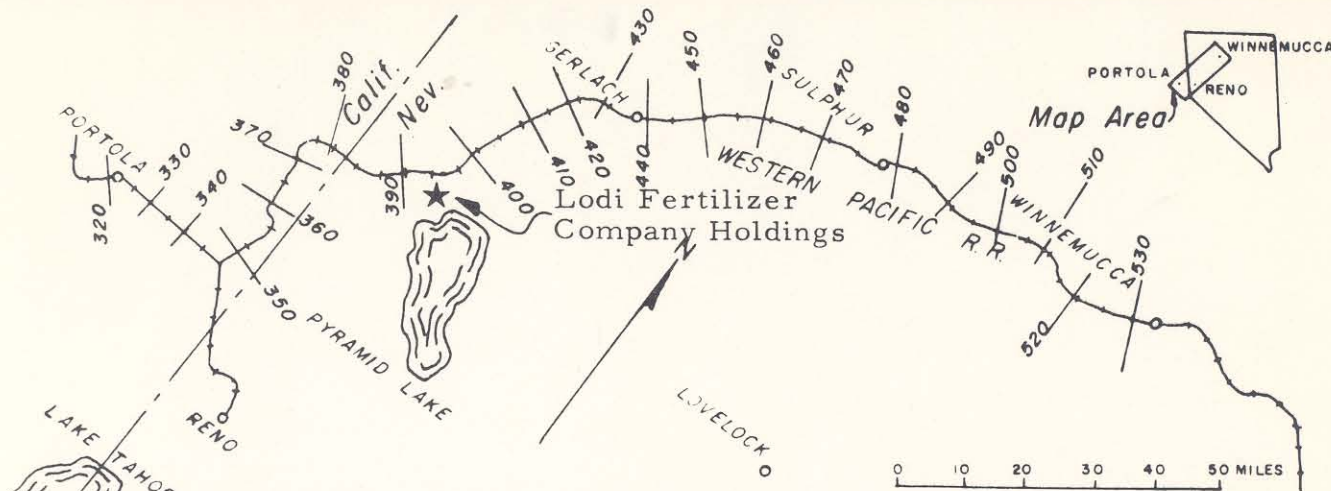

**DESCRIPTION:** Lodi Fertilizer Company, a subsidiary of Sanguinetti Fruit Company of Lodi, California, is reported to control 400 acres under lease from the Bureau of Indian Affairs and to hold in private ownership 470 acres in the Sand Pass area. Large shipments were made in 1945 and 1946.
