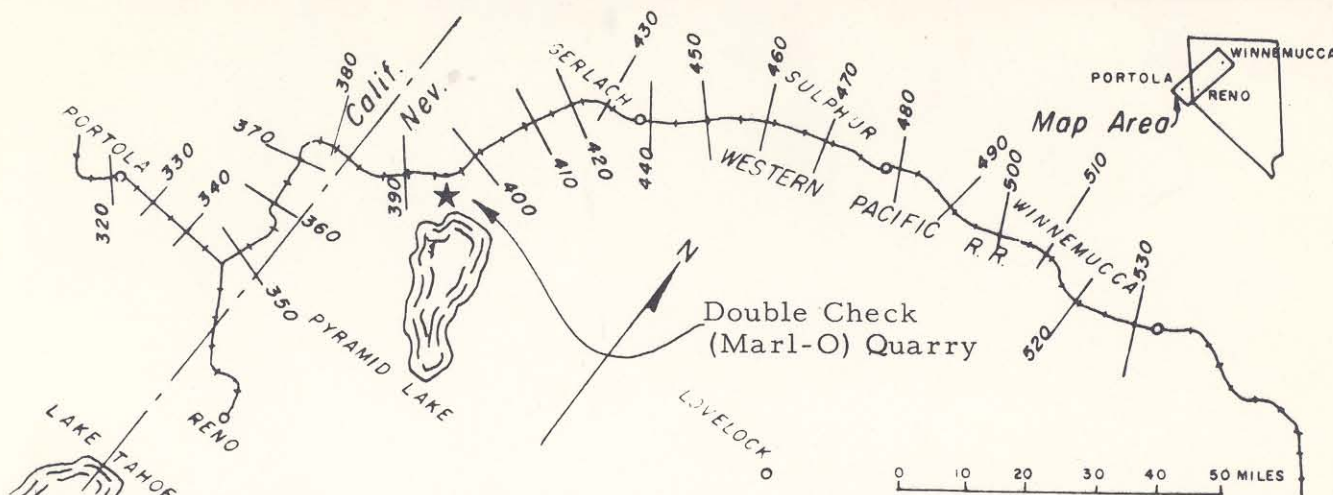

RESERVES: Rough guess 250,000 tons. Considerable amount bagged and stored under two large sheds.

ACCESS: Lies between Western Pacific and Southern Pacific Railroads. Roughly 3 miles north to Western Pacific Railroad over improved road.

OWNERSHIP: Marl Products Company, Redwood City, California.

ECONOMICS: Market needs developing.
