reached from Mina by following the county road east for 7.1 miles,

then turning morth for 1.9 miles.

Scheelite occurs in a vein in marble and line-silicate rock about 150 feet west of an exposure of quartz mensonite. The vein carries exidised silver, lead, and copper minerals in addition to tungsten.

When examined in June 1944, the deposit was opened by a shaft 15 feet deep, and was exposed in a few shallow pits for 200 feet north of the shaft. The grade of material from the shaft appeared to be 1 to 2 percent of WO₃ across a width of 5 feet. In other exposures, the tungsten content was much lower.
