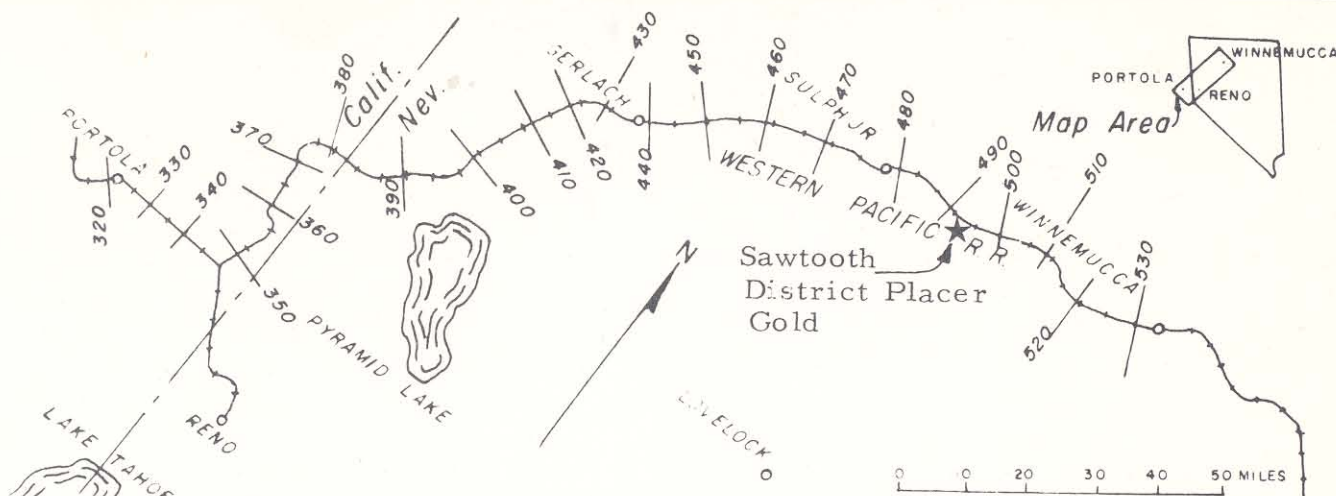

**DESCRIPTION:** Placer gold discovered 1931 by Rufus Stevens. Active 1931-1932. Total production about \$12,000.00. Placer gold has been found over a fairly level area of about 6 square miles; best values at shallow depths; much just above a false clay bedrock at depth of 8 inches to 2 feet. Gold is coarse and rough, averages about 880 fine. Small nuggets worth up to \$4.50 have been found.

**RESERVES:** Worked out.

**ACCESS:** In 1932 the Oregon Nevada Mining Co. acquired about 300 acres and attempted to work gravels on large scale - unsuccessful and acreage taken over by A. A. Goehring of Sawtooth and associates.
